Covering grades 1 to 3 or 4 to 5 in a 10-month period, Speed School has helped over 400,000 children in Ethiopia and Uganda transition to conventional primary classes, where many excel. The Ethiopian government has officially adopted the model, funding and implementing over 90% of all Speed School classes. Additionally, districts and colleges of teacher education in both Ethiopia and Uganda are using Speed School methods to improve the quality of all primary classes.
